Dear Mr. Gaillet:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 4 is in receipt of your letter dated April 8, 2013 regarding the above referenced matter. Specifically, you have requested that the Quarterly Reports (required by Paragraph 57.(a) of the Consent Decree) to be submitted based upon a Calendar Quarter, as defined in the Consent Decree. You also requested the Semi-Annual Reports' (required by Paragraph 57.(b) of the Consent Decree) and Annual Reports' (required by Paragraph 57.(c) of the Consent Decree) reporting periods and submittal dates be changed as well.

The EPA is in agreement and hereby approves these requests to change the submittal dates and reporting periods covered by the required reports. Therefore, the first Quarterly Report (Section IX., Paragraph 57.(a)), for the months of April, 2013 through June, 2013, is due to the EPA on July 30, 2013 and each subsequent Quarterly Report shall be submitted 30 days after the end of the respective Calendar Quarter, as defined in the Consent Decree. The first Semi-Annual Report (Section IX., Paragraph 57.(b)), for the months of March 1, 2013 through August 31, 2013, shall be due to the EPA on September 30, 2013 and each subsequent Semi-Annual report shall be due six months afterward. The first Annual Report (Section IX., Paragraph 57.(c)), for the months of March 1, 2013 through February 28, 2014, shall be due to the EPA on March 30, 2014 and each subsequent Annual Report shall be due one year afterward. Please note that the Semi-Annual and Annual Report cover different reporting periods and have different submittal dates than the schedule attached to your April 8, 2013 letter.
